MOC QUALITY IMPROVEMENT PROGRAMS

- Project ECHO® (Extension for Community Healthcare Outcomes)** is an innovative hub and spoke program that utilizes technology to leverage resources, foster rapid dissemination of best practices, reduce disparities and promote consistency in patient care. Then NJAAP Project ECHO® awards 25 MOC Part 4 credits upon completion.
 - Participate in 9 monthly, hour-long virtual learning sessions (i.e. ask questions, present on QI efforts), starting February 2019
 - Enter 10 patient charts once a month for 8 months into the AAP's Quality Improvement Aggregator (QIDA) system (no personal patient information collected)
 - Identify changes that can be made to improve HPV vaccination rates, and engage in ongoing tests of change via plan, do, study, act (PDSA) cycles
